CALL FOR SHORT-TERM ESPANET2022 VIENNA CONFERENCE SUPPORT

The ESPAnet's 20th Anniversary Conference will take place in Vienna (14-16 September 2022), hosted by the Department of Sociology at the Faculty of Social Sciences of the University of Vienna and we need your support.

Themes of the conference include: the pandemic, the crisis in many geopolitically diverse areas and the resulting migration flows, environmental and economic changes that extend the range of social challenges to be faced by welfare states.

The conference will address how welfare states navigate these troubled times. How they embrace change and pursue a balance between path dependency and innovation.

The 20th ESPAnet Anniversary Conference offers international scholars a place to engage, discuss and present research findings with international social policy academics in Vienna. In addition to paper presentations sessions, the program includes poster sessions and book presentations.
